We may collect the following types of information:

Personal Information You Provide

- Name, email address, phone number
- Mailing address
- Donation information (amount, date, method)
- Information submitted through forms (volunteer interest, contact forms, program applications)

Automatically Collected Information

- IP address
- Browser type and device information
- Pages visited and time spent on the site
- Cookies and similar tracking technologies

We do **not** knowingly collect information from children under 13.

2. How We Use Your Information

We use your information to:

- Process donations and provide tax-deductible receipts
- Communicate updates, newsletters, and program information
- Respond to inquiries and provide support
- Improve website functionality and user experience
- Maintain accurate donor and program records

- Comply with legal, financial, and reporting obligations required of 501(c)(3) organizations

We do **not** sell, rent, or trade your personal information.

3. Donor Privacy

The Minette Foundation respects and protects donor confidentiality.

We will **not** share, publish, or disclose donor names or personal information without consent, except:

- When required by law
- When necessary to process a donation
- When a donor chooses to make their gift public

Donors may request anonymity at any time.

4. Sharing of Information

We may share information with:

- Trusted service providers (payment processors, email platforms)
- Legal or regulatory authorities when required
- Partner organizations only with your explicit permission

All third-party vendors must comply with privacy and security standards.

5. Data Security

We use administrative, technical, and physical safeguards to protect your information from unauthorized access, loss, or misuse. While no system is completely secure, we follow industry-standard practices for nonprofit data protection.

6. Your Choices

You may:

- Opt out of email communications
- Request access to your personal information

- Request deletion of your information, where legally permissible
