

Donation Impact Guide for Hogar Madelaes & El Centro de Corrección y Rehabilitación Najayo Mujeres

All amounts in USD; based on Dominican Republic bulk pricing and NGO procurement averages (typical prices that nonprofit organizations pay when purchasing goods in bulk)

PERSONAL HYGIENE & BASIC NEEDS IMPACT

\$100

- Provides **40–50 bars of soap, 20–25 toothbrushes, and 20 tubes of toothpaste**
- Covers **one week of sanitary pads** for **15–20 women** at Najayo Mujeres

\$250

- Supplies **one month of hygiene kits** (soap, toothpaste, toothbrush, deodorant, pads) for **30 girls** at Hogar Madelaes
- Purchases **20 towels + 20 washcloths** for new admissions

\$500

- Provides **full hygiene kits for 60–70 incarcerated women** at Najayo Mujeres
- Covers **one month of diapers, wipes, and baby soap** for infants/toddlers living at Madelaes

\$1,000

- Purchases **3–4 months of hygiene supplies** for all girls at Hogar Madelaes
 - Funds **100–120 complete women’s hygiene kits** for Najayo Mujeres
 - Covers **basic medical supplies** (acetaminophen, ointments, bandages) for 2–3 months

HOGAR MADALAES OPERATING IMPACT

\$2,500

- Covers **two weeks of food** for 30–40 girls
- Funds **school supplies, notebooks, and uniforms** for 15–20 girls

- Repairs **broken fans, lights, or mattresses**

\$5,000

- Pays for **one full month of operating expenses** at Hogar Madalaes, including:
 - Food
 - Electricity & water
 - Cleaning supplies
 - Transportation
 - Staff stipends
 - Basic medical needs

\$10,000

- Funds **two full months of operations**
 - Allows the home to purchase **new mattresses, bedding, and clothing** for all girls
 - Supports **internet access + educational materials** for remote learning

NAJAYO MUJERES IMPACT

\$500

- Provides **hygiene kits for 60–70 women**
- Supplies **underwear, socks, and bras** for 20–25 women

\$1,500

- Funds **three months of vocational materials** (sewing supplies, notebooks, pens)
- Provides **nutritional supplements** for pregnant or postpartum women

\$3,000

- Supports **a full quarter of mental health and wellness programming**, including:
 - Journals
 - Art therapy materials
 - Group workshop supplies
 - Educational handouts

\$7,500

- Funds **six months of vocational training**, including sewing, crafts, and literacy materials
 - Provides **hygiene kits for the entire women's population** for 3–4 months

\$25,000+ Transformational Gift

A gift of this size could:

- **Renovate sleeping areas** at Hogar Madalaes (mattresses, fans, paint, storage)
- **Build a dedicated wellness/education room** at Najayo Mujeres
- Fund **six months of operations** at Hogar Madalaes
- Launch a **pilot mental health program** for incarcerated women
